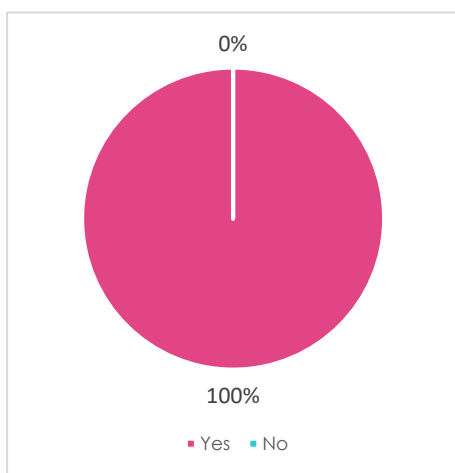
St Michael's C of E Academy



We received a total of 63 responses from pupils across our School, which gives a 97% response rate. We are thrilled that our children love coming to school and are happy and fulfilled.

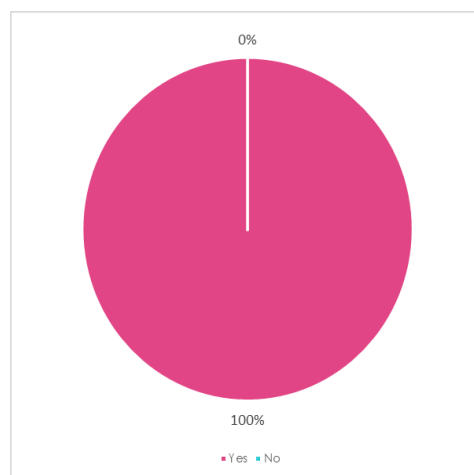
“Love helps us to be kind, wisdom makes us make wise choices, community helps us to be kind to each other”

100% of our children are proud to attend St Michael's. The children commented on how they were also proud of themselves and each other for developing their learning.

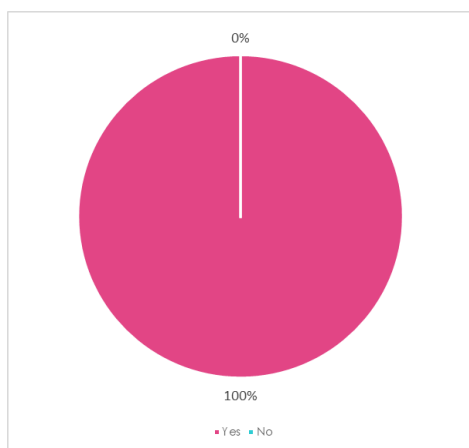
I feel listened to and have a voice in my class and my school community?



All our children agreed they felt they were listened to and had a voice within our school community.

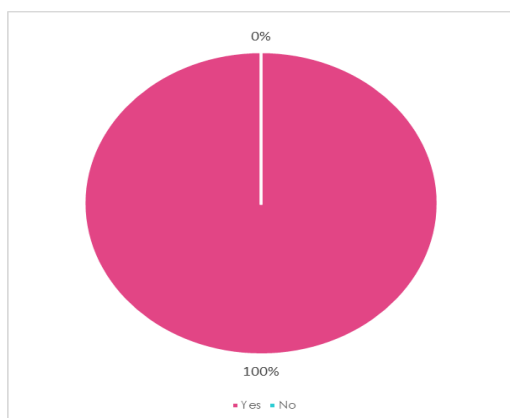


Do the school values help you to understand how to live together as a school



Our children agreed that the school values helped them to understand how to live together as a school, teaching them to be kind and inclusive.

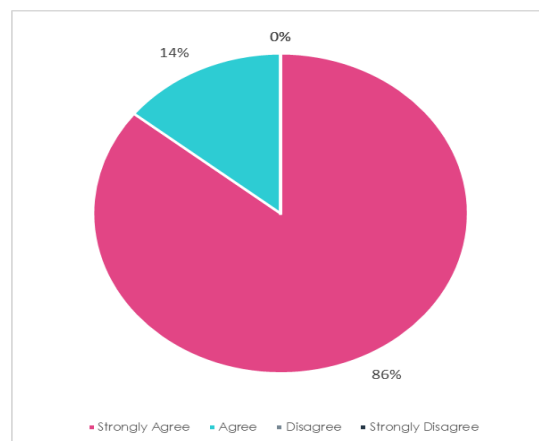
Does your teacher help you when you find things hard?



100% of our children agreed their teacher helped them when they were finding things hard. It is so positive that they feel confident in approaching them when they need to.

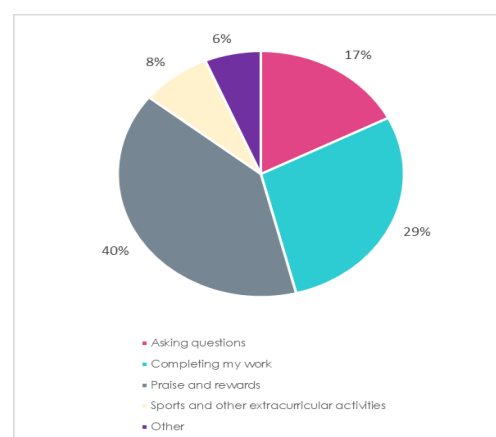
“I'm proud of everyone in my class for being star of the week.”

Here are some of the things our children identified;

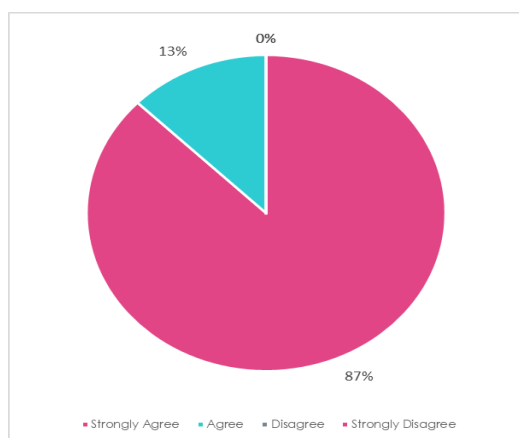
“Doing well in my times tables”

“Learning more in science”

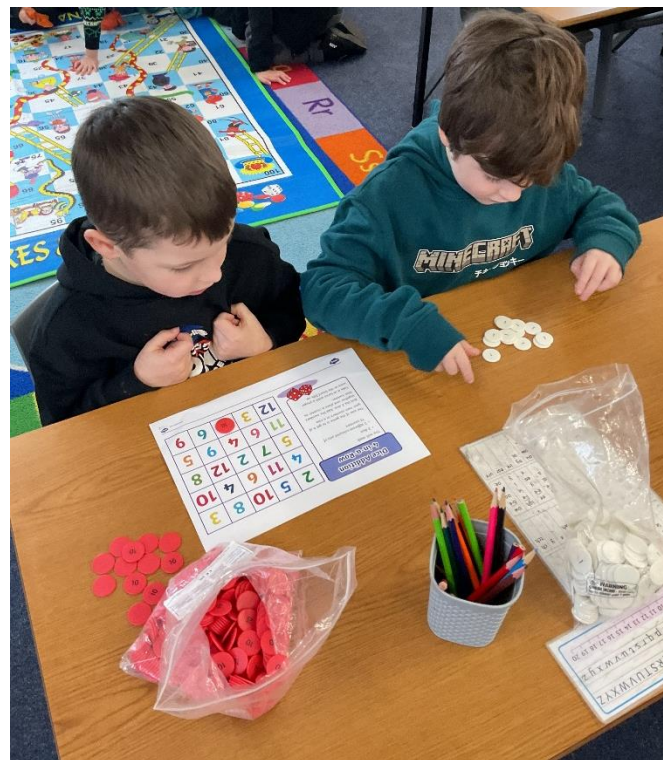
“Doing my independent writing”

“We would have school pets”

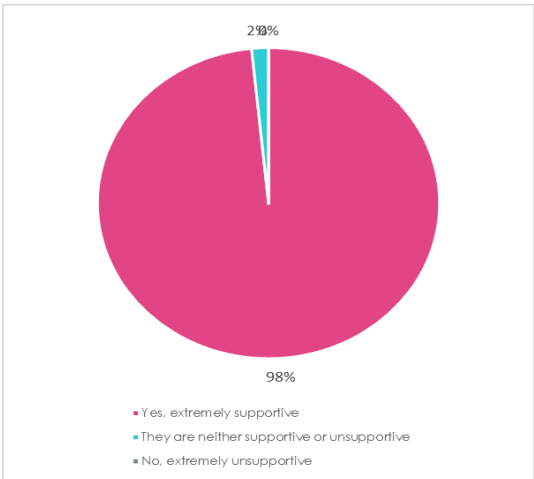
“ Do even more learning”

“I want grass to grow and loads of flowers too”

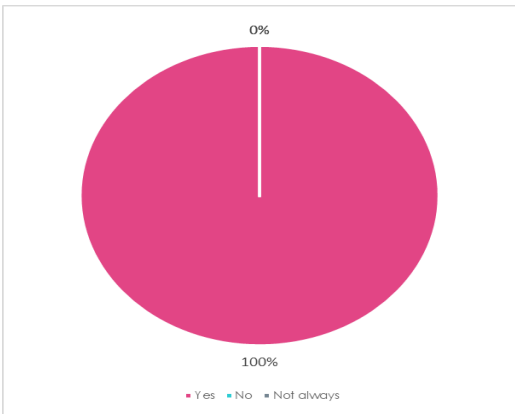
“A big sandpit for everyone to use, bikes to use in the playground, a climbing frame, a climbing wall”

Do you think that the school provides you with enough sports / musical opportunities?

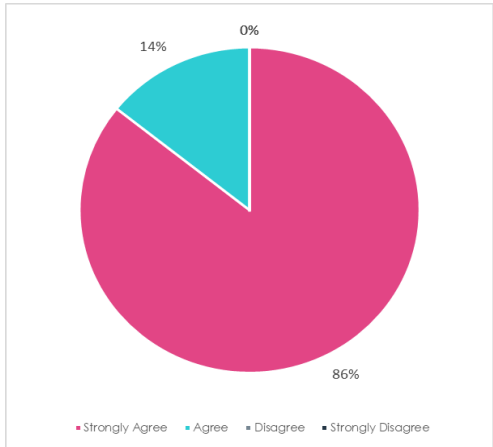


All our children agreed they have ample sports and musical opportunities



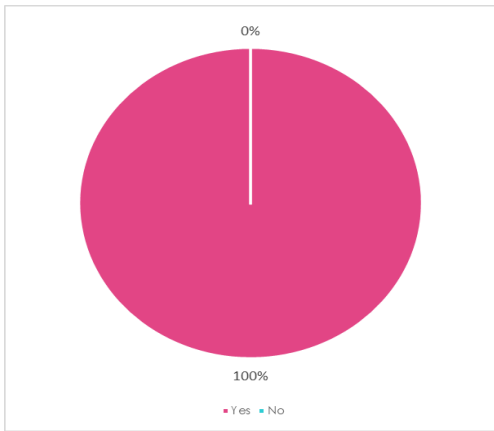
“They help us love each other and focus on our school community. If we didn't have values it would be hard”

In my class there are clear expectations for behaviour and it's fair



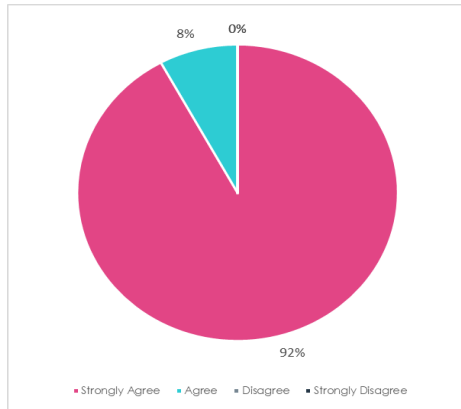
100% of the children felt there were fair expectations about behaviour
